# **July Visitors**

A combined team from Massachusetts' Clifton Lutheran Church in Marblehead and Sovereign Grace Community Church in Peabody used their talents to construct a house for a family in need. They also used the four brand new sewing machines they carried to Haiti to teach 60 students practical sewing skills. Their goal was for students to make one marketable item by the end of the week. This was the kick start to teaching our high school students vocational skills.

TJ Widbin, his mom Vickee, and her grandson Brendon joined us from Iowa. TJ brought five water treatment devices with him that use salt water to produce chlorine. TJ tested the local water to determine how much chlorine it requires. This gift will allow the five sites using the devices to produce homemade chlorine for less than the cost of imported chlorine, creating both a small business and healthy opportunities for their communities.

Cheryl "Chel" Finn also spent a week with us. It's always good to see Chel and have her invaluable help as a healthcare provider. She and Vickee, a registered nurse, worked in the clinic with Leah.
